Report RUN 1502

Hash Run at Fadden Pines, 21 September 2009

Hare: Mixo

Run Number: 1502 according to **Hidden Flagon**; 1500 by the accounting of the Hash Cash, **Soft Centre**. It takes a committee to determine the Run Number, and they still can't come to an agreement without a public squabble in the circle. The Fat Cat Hash strikes again!! (It was the Grand Master who prevailed and **Soft Centre** was the one given a down-down for impertinence. 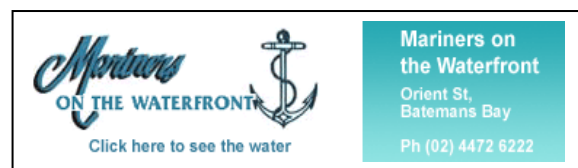
Early arrivers are meeting and boozing on at the Mariners on Friday night.
