Run Report – Duckhead’s Spring Freeze Run – Gungahlin - 28 September 2009

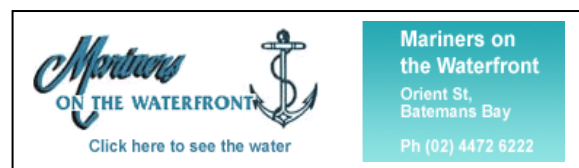
Early arrivers are meeting and boozing on at the Mariners on Friday night.
